

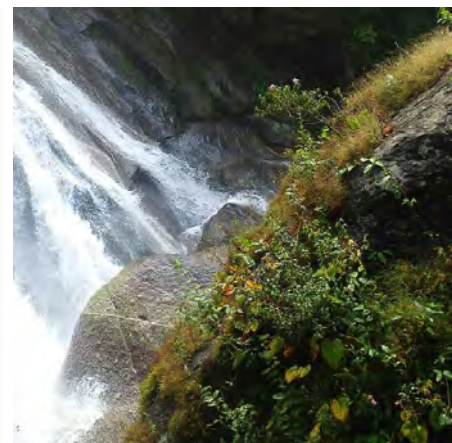
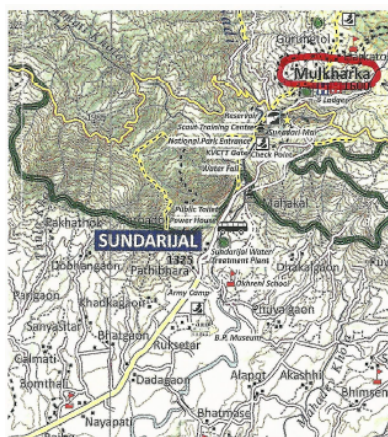


Lumo Karmo – House of the White Lady Snake Training and Guest House in the Shivapuri National Park

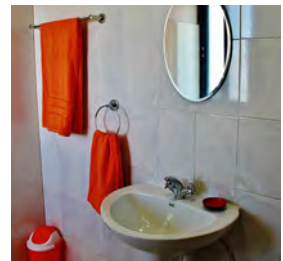
Our Restaurant has many Cosy Corners
